The concepts of space and symmetry play a central role in the new In Between centre base tables, designed by Sami Kallio for &Tradition.

A new addition to the In Between series of tables and chairs, the round table features a contemporary central base instead of traditional legs. “Using classic wood craftsmanship techniques together with modern machinery, the In Between table has a Nordic soul that unites the past with the present,” explains Kallio. “The cylindrical column allows more people to sit comfortably around it, regardless of the setting.”

Equally at home in a commercial or private environment, and opening up space rather than occupying it, the table comprises a black powder-coated steel base and circular top, offered in range of materials — from natural wood veneer to durable linoleum and innovative Fenix, known for its tactile surface and repellent properties.

Holding a Master’s degree in design and trained as a carpenter, Finnish-born Sami Kallio is an award-winning designer based in Sweden. His in-depth understanding of wood and traditional craftsmanship techniques melds with modern materials and manufacturing methods to create universally appealing designs.
